## KERN COUNTY FIRE HAZARD REDUCTION PROGRAM MUST BE COMPLETED BY JUNE 1st



## REQUIRED CLEARANCE GUIDELINES

- > 100' clearance around ALL structures. Two zones make up the required 100' of defensible space
- Zone 1- extending 30' from the structure, remove ALL non-ornamental combustible fuels in this area
- **Zone 2- 30' to 100'** from the structure, <u>reduce</u> **ALL** combustible fuels in this area
- > 10' clearance around stovepipe/chimney outlets
- 10' clearance around LPG tanks
- > 10' clearance around ALL property lines of vacant lots that encroach on the 100' defensible space of neighboring structures
- > Remove accumulation of combustible fuels on vacant properties that can be deemed a fire hazard
- Remove all dead limbs that are overhanging any structures
- > Remove lower limbs of all non-ornamental trees to a height of 6' off the ground
- > Clear roof of all combustible vegetation and debris
