On Thursday, May 11, 2017, at about 1225 hours, I responded to [REDACTED] regarding a rape that just occurred. The reporting party, [REDACTED], advised officers over the radio that a sexual assault had just occurred, and he had the suspect in custody.

Upon my arrival, I made contact with [REDACTED] on the east side of the campus, near the Fine Arts building. [REDACTED] had a subject in handcuffs. The subject was later identified as MALCOLM JOHNSON. JOHNSON is described as a:

Black male, 19 years old, black curly hair, wearing red shorts, no shirt, and tennis shoes

[REDACTED] advised me the victim of the sexual assault was seated in a vehicle parked in front of mine. I searched JOHNSON and had him sit in the rear seat of my patrol vehicle pending the completion of my investigation. [REDACTED] staff secured the restroom where the incident occurred until additional officers arrived. No one was allowed inside the women's restroom. Once additional officers arrived, Officer Peck #1112, McNamara #1193 and I established and maintained a crime scene around the women's restroom.

I made contact with the victim, identified as [REDACTED]. I immediately noticed [REDACTED] appeared distraught. [REDACTED] was shaking and crying. I asked [REDACTED] if she would tell me what happened. [REDACTED] told me she took a break from her finals and went to use the women's restroom at the Fine Arts building. [REDACTED] told me she walked inside the women's restroom and entered a stall. [REDACTED] said as she readied herself to use the restroom, the lights went out. [REDACTED] said the restroom was completely dark, and she could not see anything inside the room. [REDACTED] attempted to locate her cellphone for a light source. [REDACTED] said as she looked for her cellphone, an unknown male subject attacked her and began to strangle her from behind with his forearms. [REDACTED] said she tried to fight the subject, but she was not able to because she could not breathe. [REDACTED] said she pleaded with the subject to release her because she could not breathe. [REDACTED] said the subject released the hold across her neck slightly. [REDACTED] told me the subject then told her he would kill her if she screamed. [REDACTED] said the subject stuck one of his hands down

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the front of her pants, inside her underwear. [REDACTED] said the subject touched her vagina, but she was unsure if the subject's fingers penetrated her in any way. [REDACTED] said the subject then pulled her pants and underwear down to her ankles and forced her to the ground near the back of the stall.

[REDACTED] said the subject attempted to insert his penis into her mouth when she was on the ground. [REDACTED] said she struggled with the subject, and he was not able to insert his penis into her mouth; however, the subject's penis made contact with her nose. [REDACTED] said the [REDACTED] Public Safety Officers entered the restroom at that time. The subject fled from the stall [REDACTED] was in and hid inside another stall. [REDACTED] said she put her pants on and left.

[REDACTED] told me she nearly "blacked out" during the incident, and, as a result, could not remember certain details of the incident. [REDACTED] said the bathroom was so dark she never saw the subject's face. [REDACTED] said she could not see the subject at all because the room was so dark. I ended my interview with [REDACTED].

I responded to the women's restroom. I saw the Fine Arts building is transcended by a hallway with lockable access doors on either side. The hallway runs from northwest to southeast. The hallway is devoid of any features, except for the lockable women's restroom door, which is directly in the center of the hallway. The women's restroom is situated on the east side of the hallway, with the door facing west. There is only one entrance to the women's restroom. The women's restroom consists of about three bathroom stalls, a sink, and a mirror on the north wall, near the door. The restroom door swings outward, with its hinges on the south side of the door. I conducted a protective sweep of the restroom and found dried blood on the floor. I also located a gray t-shirt and a cellphone on the floor. I exited the restroom so it could be processed by Crime Lab personnel.

I spoke to [REDACTED] about what he saw. [REDACTED] told me he received a report of a male subject in the women's restroom in the Fine Arts building. [REDACTED] and his partner, [REDACTED], responded to the restroom and found both hallway access doors were locked from inside. [REDACTED] opened the north hallway door and went to the restroom, which was also locked from inside. [REDACTED] said he located JOHNSON inside of a stall inside the restroom. [REDACTED] said he took JOHNSON into custody. [REDACTED] said JOHNSON spontaneously stated that he had paid "her".

[REDACTED] advised me their office has been receiving regular reports of a subject similar in description to JOHNSON that has been seen in or

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loitering around women's restrooms on campus. [REDACTED] said in each incident he has not been able to locate the subject.

I spoke to [REDACTED], who stated when he and [REDACTED] entered the restroom, he saw [REDACTED] was on the floor of the restroom. [REDACTED] said [REDACTED] was crying and trying to pull her pants and underwear up. [REDACTED] said JOHNSON was hiding inside of a bathroom stall and momentarily resisted arrest, but they were able to place him in handcuffs. [REDACTED] said he heard sounds of a struggle when he first went into the restroom. [REDACTED] said their time of call was 1212 hours.

I was later directed to the reporting party for the campus security, identified as [REDACTED]. I obtained [REDACTED] recorded statement. The following is a summary of [REDACTED] statement and is not verbatim. For further, more in-depth details, refer to the audio recording. [REDACTED] told me on today's date, at about 1150 hours, she went to the Fine Arts women's restroom. [REDACTED] said both hallway doors were closed when she arrived. [REDACTED] said she opened the hallway door and found the lights in the hallway had been turned off. [REDACTED] said the women's bathroom door was propped completely open with the lights on. [REDACTED] said she went inside the restroom. [REDACTED] said she noticed something was moving behind her as she washed her hands, but did not know what it was. [REDACTED] said she checked her lip gloss in the mirror near the restroom entrance and saw eyes looking at her through the crack between the open door and the door jamb. [REDACTED] said she confronted the subject who was hiding behind the door. [REDACTED] said the subject, who she described as a:

Black (possible mixed race-light skinned) male, 18 to 19 years old, 5'6" to 5'7", athletic build, curly hair, wearing a red baseball hat backwards, gray t-shirt, dark colored cargo shorts, long socks, and possible Vans brand shoes. [REDACTED] said the subject had severe acne

claimed to be a janitor, but [REDACTED] could not see any indications that he was actually a janitor. [REDACTED] realized something was wrong and notified [REDACTED] staff, who notified security. I later downloaded the audio recording into DIMS.

Sergeant McCauley #1056 was notified of and present for this incident. Detective Abshire #936 and detectives from the Special Victims Unit arrived and assumed the investigation. Officer Peck transported JOHNSON to the Bakersfield Police Department. Refer to Officer Peck's supplemental report for further information. Officer McNamara transported [REDACTED] to the Bakersfield Police Department.

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Through the course of their investigation, detectives learned JOHNSON provided me a false name at the scene. I conducted a search of the DMV database using JOHNSON's information and found the photograph of the actual JOHNSON was not the subject I took into custody. I was provided with the actual suspect name of BRANDON ROBINSON. I conducted a records check of the DMV database and located ROBINSON's DMV photograph. ROBINSON was, in fact, the subject I took into custody. In this report, when I refer to JOHNSON, I am actually referring to ROBINSON as that was the alias ROBINSON went by at the time of his arrest.

recorder and recorded ROBINSONS spontaneous statement. ROBINSON told me
that he is a good student and has never been in trouble before. ROBINSON
the then told me he was wrong and he was going to have to confess to what
he did. ROBINSON also told me the girl that spoke to the officers is telling
the truth. For further details refer to the digital recording. I later
downloaded the recording into DIMS.

After arriving at the BPD headquarters building I escorted ROBINSON to the
interview rooms where he was later contacted by detectives.

I arrived at about 1305 hrs and made contact with Officer S. RONFELDT #1304 who was on scene. I was advised the suspect was in custody and had verbally provided the name of

MALCOLM JOHNSON DOB: 07/14/1997.

Later in the investigation it was determined the suspects true name is

BRANDON NATANIEL ROBINSON 08/01/1997.

For further details on Officer RONFELDT'S initial investigation see the report accomplished by him.

I was advised two [REDACTED] security officers had walked in and interrupted the offense and had detained the suspect (ROBINSON) inside the rest room where the offense took place. For further details on the statements and identification of the security officers see the supplemental report accomplished by Officer C. ABSHIRE #936. I arranged for patrol officers to transport ROBINSON to the Bakersfield Police Department to further this Investigation.

I spoke briefly with the victim, [REDACTED] who had been taken to a nearby room on the campus. I then arranged for another patrol officer to transport [REDACTED] to the Bakersfield Police Department to further this investigation.

While at the Bakersfield Police Department I spoke with the victim, [REDACTED] briefly and then waited for Detective ABSHIRE to arrive and then we both conducted an interview with [REDACTED]. This interview was conducted in the interview room inside the Special Victims Unit office. This interview was both audio and visually recorded without the knowledge or permission of [REDACTED]. I later downloaded the audio recorded to BPD DIMS. I have requested the video recording and will book it into the property room when it is put on a DVD. The following is a synopsis of the interview and is not verbatim or in chronological order.

[REDACTED] signed a Bakersfield Police Department confidentiality waiver form to keep her name confidential. I later had this scanned into the report.

I explained a sexual assault exam and offered it to [REDACTED]. She later told me that she wanted the sexual assault exam and Detective SCHLOSSER later took [REDACTED] to the Kern SART Center where this exam was conducted.

[REDACTED] stated she is a student at Bakersfield College and went to this college today to take a final exam. She said she arrived at the college at about 1130 hrs. and was driven there by her mother [REDACTED]. She stated she sat in the car for about 10 minutes and then went to her class room where she dropped off some things, she was in the class room for about 10 minutes or so and then went check another grade and use the rest room before taking this final exam.

[REDACTED] said she is familiar with the rest rooms where this sexual assault took place and has been in and around this area while going to school here. She said as she arrived at the hallway that contains the rest room, the closest door was closed which is unusual. She opened this door and entered the hall way and walked to the rest room which had an open door. She described this rest room door as being propped open. She said the lights were all on as usual. She did not remember if the door on the far side or south side of the hallway was open or not. She said she did not see anyone else in the hallway or rest room as she entered.

[REDACTED] told me that as she entered the rest room she checked the first two stalls and found them empty but they are smaller than the third stall so she went into that one and used it. She said when she finished she exited the stall to use the sink. As she walked up to the sink the lights went out and she thought there was a power outage. She said she stopped and listened to hear if she could hear anything and then began to get her telephone out to use for a light source.

Before she could get her telephone out she said she was grabbed from behind by her shoulders. She said she started to scream as loud as she could and tried to kick and hit whoever was grabbing her. She said the suspect then put his arm around her neck and he tightened his arm and told her not to scream. She said she continued

to try and fight the suspect off and he told her not to scream or he would kill her. He told [REDACTED] "I'll kill you, don't scream, don't scream, I'll kill you." She said, she then stopped screaming and she began to choke or cough because of how much pressure was put on her neck as the suspect choked her and she believes the suspect thought she was starting to scream again. She said he tightened his arm again as hard as he could and she told him she couldn't breathe. She described the inside area of the suspect's elbow as the part he had around her neck. She said during part of the time the suspect was choking her, she couldn't breathe or swallow.

[REDACTED] said she has red marks on her neck that were caused while the suspect was choking her. She said when she stopped making noises she believes the suspect believed she was not going to scream again. She said at this time the suspect put his hand down the front of her pants, with his bare hand going under her pants and under her underwear. She said during this time he had been standing behind her with his chest to her back.

[REDACTED] said at this time her pants were completely up and buttoned. She said the suspect's bare hand touched her vagina or "clit". She is unsure if the suspect's fingers penetrated her vagina or not but the fingers did touch her vagina.

She said, she is on her period and she is uncertain if he felt blood or anything. She said she was wearing feminine pad. She said the suspect then turned her to face the wall or corner which would be the furthest corner from the door by the far end of the sinks.

[REDACTED] said at this time the suspect pulled her pants and underwear down to about her knees. She said his chest was still at back with the suspect standing behind her. She said it was still dark at this time and she was trying to feel for the wall to find out where she was. She said she never had a chance to get her phone out before the attack and believes it fell out of her pants when the suspect pulled her pants down. [REDACTED] had on pants that looked like blue jeans but they are a stretchable fabric. She said it felt at this time like he was masturbating while he was behind her as she could feel his arm moving in that type of a motion. [REDACTED] said the suspect told her to bend over at this time. She said at this time she doesn't know if the suspect pushed her down or if she fell down, but she landed on the ground in a sitting position now facing towards the suspect. [REDACTED] said at this time the suspect was trying to put his penis in her mouth. She said she was continually moving her head and mouth to keep him from getting his penis into her mouth. She said she was saying something similar to "no, no, please don't". She said the suspect's penis was touching her nose during time. She said she could smell his penis at this time. She believes this went on for about 10 seconds. She said at this time it is still dark inside the rest room.

[REDACTED] said the lights of the rest room then came on. [REDACTED] said she screamed "no" because she was "naked" and there were more people coming in. [REDACTED] said as the lights came on the two security officers came into the rest room. She said she could now see the suspect for the first time because the lights were now on and she saw that the suspect was now trying to pull up his shorts and he ran into one of the rest room stalls. She said she started pulling her pants up.

[REDACTED] said one of the security officers stayed by the door and other went to the stall the suspect had run into and pushed the suspect onto the ground and handcuffed him. She said she was about 4 feet away from the suspect at this time and the lights were on. She said she does not know the suspect and has not seen him before. She said she does not recognize the suspect's voice.

[REDACTED] believes as the uniformed security officers entered the rest room after turning on the lights, the suspect later identified as BRANDON ROBINSON was still in the open area of the rest room. She said the suspect was trying to pull up his shorts and he ran into the rest room stall. She said she remembers seeing red on the shorts she didn't remember if they were red or had a red stripe. She doesn't believe he had a shirt on.

[REDACTED] said the same person she saw the security officers handcuff was the same person she saw next to her when the lights came on.

There are no further details at this time.

Detective F. ESGUERRA #1025 and I interviewed BRANDON ROBINSON in the Special Victims Unit interview room. Detective ESGUERRA joined me in this interview because ROBINSON matched the suspect description in another similar case that Detective ESGUERRA had worked, but the suspect was still outstanding and unidentified until today, that case number is 17-87841. Detective ESGUERRA was also familiar with another similar case which is assigned to Detective K. CASON #1102 under case number 17-47969 in which the suspect was outstanding and unidentified, ROBINSON also matched the description of this suspect. During this interview BRANDON ROBINSON admitted to being the suspect responsible for all three cases being investigated. This report will focus on this investigation under case 17-103871 that occurred today at [REDACTED] located [REDACTED]. For further details regarding the parts of the interview for case numbers 17-87841 and 17-47969 see the reports under those case numbers.

This entire interview was both audio and visually recorded without the knowledge or permission of BRANDON ROBINSON. There was a small digital recorder in partial view and at one point when ROBINSON was alone in the interview after the majority of the interview had been conducted he took the recorder from Detective ESGUERRA'S portfolio and deleted the recording. This interview room was still being video and audio recorded from other sources and the recording from the small digital recorder was later recovered. See Detective ESGUERRA'S reports (17-87841) for further details on this portion of the investigation.

I also recorded the second portion of these interviews with my small digital recorder and later downloaded that to BPD DIMS. The DVD video recording of this entire interview was booked into the property room as evidence.

The following is a synopsis of the interview regarding case number 17-103871 and is not verbatim or in chronological order. For the exact interview see and listen to the recordings of the entire interview.

Detective ESGUERRA read BRANDON ROBINSON his Miranda rights from his department issued Miranda card. ROBINSON told us that he understood each of these Miranda rights. ROBINSON then began answering questions.

ROBINSON told us that he is a student at [REDACTED] and plays football there. He said he was there today to waiting to hear about a final grade and to take a final. He said he was texting and talking by telephone with a girl he only knows by the name of "[REDACTED]" who he has been seeing romantically. ROBINSON said he was going to try and meet with her by the bath room. He said he does not have "[REDACTED]" saved a contact in his phone but knows that her phone number starts with [REDACTED]. He does not know the last name of "[REDACTED]" and did not identify her any further. He said he saw a girl go into the bath room and thought it was "[REDACTED]" and he waited for her come out and then found out it wasn't "[REDACTED]". ROBINSON said he was going to scare "[REDACTED]".

ROBINSON said he entered the bath room and did not know who was inside of it because it was "pitch black". He said it happened because he was selfish and stupid. He said he turned off the lights because he didn't want to be ashamed. Detective ESGUERRA asked ROBINSON what he did with his penis and if his penis entered the victims vagina or anus. ROBINSON said "almost in her butt, but it didn't get that far". He said he tried to go for the butt. Detective ESGUERRA told ROBINSON that the victim told us that his penis came in contact with her mouth. I then began asking questions and reminded ROBINSON he had said at one point he let go of the victim and I asked him what he meant by that. I asked him if he pushed her or if she fell. He told me that he did not push her, but did let go of her and she just ended up on the ground. He said she may have fallen. ROBINSON confirmed that his shorts were down at this time and his penis was out. He said his penis did hit her face and he said his penis did hit her nose. He confirmed he saw the victim walk into the rest room. I asked ROBINSON if he knew the victim or had seen or talked to the victim before or if he had ever talked to her before, ROBINSON shook his head in the negative by going side to side. He confirmed that he saw the first lady come out of the bath room, then saw the victim walk into the bath room. ROBINSON confirmed he then entered the bath room and turned off the lights. ROBINSON said it was too dark to see what the victim was doing but he knew she was in the main area of the bath room and not in a stall.

ROBINSON said he was standing behind the victim when he pulled her pants down. ROBINSON confirmed that he put his hand down her pants before pulling her pants down and touched her vagina and then pulled her pants down and tried to put his penis in her butt.

ROBINSON said the victim was yelling during this incident. He said it would be correct to say the victim was screaming. ROBINSON said he told the victim to be quiet or something similar to, everything will be fine, just be quiet. ROBINSON denied saying anything about hurting the victim if she didn't quit screaming. He denied saying anything about killing the victim.

I confirmed with ROBINSON that he came up behind the victim, grabbed her, she screamed, he told her to be quiet. He then confirmed that he put his hand down the front of her pants and he touched her vagina with his hand and his hand was under her underwear. He then pulled her pants down. He then pulled his shorts down and exposed his penis and tried to put it in her butt but didn't get it in.

On 05/11/17, I was informed officers had detained BRANDON ROBINSON (19 years old) for a sexual abuse incident (17-103871) that occurred at [REDACTED]. Detective Wimbish told me what the victim had reported and BRANDON ROBINSON's description. Based on what I had learned, I suspected BRANDON ROBINSON was possibly the suspect in not only this investigation, but also the suspect in case number 17-87841. This was based on his description, which matched what had been provided by [REDACTED] and the type of offense that was committed at [REDACTED] was similar to what [REDACTED] provided.

At about 1728 hours, Detective Wimbish and I interviewed BRANDON ROBINSON at the Bakersfield Police Department, located at 1601 Truxtun Avenue. Our conversation was digitally recorded. I informed BRANDON ROBINSON we needed to speak to him about not only today's incident, but also about what had happened about a few months ago. I explained to BRANDON ROBINSON that what occurred was not an accurate representation of who he was and he agreed.

I then advised BRANDON ROBINSON of his Miranda rights, which he stated he understood. The following is a synopsis of what was learned. During our interview with BRANDON ROBINSON, he admitted to all 3 offenses. For further information regarding his statements about the other two incidents (17-103871 / 17-87841), refer to the reports under those case numbers.

Regarding his statement about this incident, I asked him about what happened on [REDACTED]. BRANDON ROBINSON initially denied having anything to do with that incident, but sometime after Detective Wimbish spoke to BRANDON ROBINSON about today's incident, I again spoke to him about the incident on Wenatchee Avenue.

I informed BRANDON ROBINSON about the time and date of the incident on Wenatchee Avenue. I also showed him a picture of the victim, [REDACTED]. He was asked if there would be any reason why his DNA could be found on her, and he stated he did not believe so, but he then stated he did not know. I told BRANDON ROBINSON about [REDACTED] stating that some came from behind her; did something to her, and pointed a firearm at her. Later, I realized the comment about the firearm being pointed was not correct. Again, he initially denied the allegations, but he then admitted to being responsible for the assault, and he would provide details that only the suspect and [REDACTED] would know.

Around the time of the incident, BRANDON ROBINSON stated he was residing in the area of Mount Vernon and Columbus Street. He was living there with his 2 friends who he could only identify as "[REDACTED]" and "[REDACTED]". During the night of the incident, he again stated he was not in his right mind. While out, he was looking for "money". BRANDON ROBINSON stated he took \$100.00 from the victim's purse and left her purse at the scene.

When the incident initially occurred, he stated he walked up from behind [REDACTED] and put her "over the bricks", which was exactly what the victim had stated. After doing so, he pulled his "thing out", but he never put his "thing" in her. I asked BRANDON ROBINSON how [REDACTED] clothes came off, but he did not answer. I asked him if he threatened [REDACTED] and he said, "yeah, probably", but he could not recall what he said to her. I asked him what he did with his penis and he stated he put his penis on her "butt". He also admitted to touching the victim with his fingers.

On 5-12-2017 I (Detective Cason #1102) was assigned to the Bakersfield Police Department Special Victims Unit. I received notification that on 5-11-2017 additional Detectives of the Special Victims Unit arrested a suspect, identified as BRANDON ROBINSON, who was contacted during a separate sexual assault under case #17-103871.

I made contact with the victim from 3-3-2017 identified as [REDACTED]. I digitally recorded my conversation with [REDACTED] and later downloaded it into DIMS. The following is a summary of our conversation and is not verbatim. [REDACTED] informed me that she had been walking on a sidewalk in the [REDACTED] block of [REDACTED] during the initial attack. I asked [REDACTED] if ROBINSON forced her to a different area for the assault to occur. [REDACTED] informed me that ROBINSON pushed her against a brick wall that ran along the sidewalk of the residence she was walking next to. [REDACTED] estimated that ROBINSON moved her approximately 2-3 feet. I asked [REDACTED] if ROBINSON made any additional statements to her during the offense that she did not tell officers on the night of the offense. [REDACTED] stated the only other statement was ROBINSON told her "Don't scream and you'll be alright". [REDACTED] stated that ROBINSON made no statements about himself. [REDACTED] informed me that she only "somewhat" saw his face due to lighting. I asked [REDACTED] if ROBINSON only touched the outside of her vagina with his penis and was not able to penetrate her which she stated was true. [REDACTED] told me she believes ROBINSON was attempting to have sexual intercourse with her. [REDACTED] stated that ROBINSON rubbed her vagina from the back of her with his fingers. [REDACTED] stated that ROBINSON did not penetrate her vagina or anus during the incident. I advised [REDACTED] of the photographic lineup admonition, which she stated that she understood. I showed [REDACTED] a six-pack lineup with ROBINSON located in the number 3 position. [REDACTED] was not able to identify ROBINSON in the lineup. [REDACTED] then signed the lineup and I later booked it into the BPD property room as evidence. I also had a copy of the lineup scanned into this report. I informed [REDACTED] that ROBINSON had been arrested and had admitted to the attack on her from 3-3-2017. [REDACTED] was very pleased with the arrest of ROBINSON and informed me she would be happy to participate in the investigation in anyway. I thanked [REDACTED] for her time and ended my conversation with her. No further information.

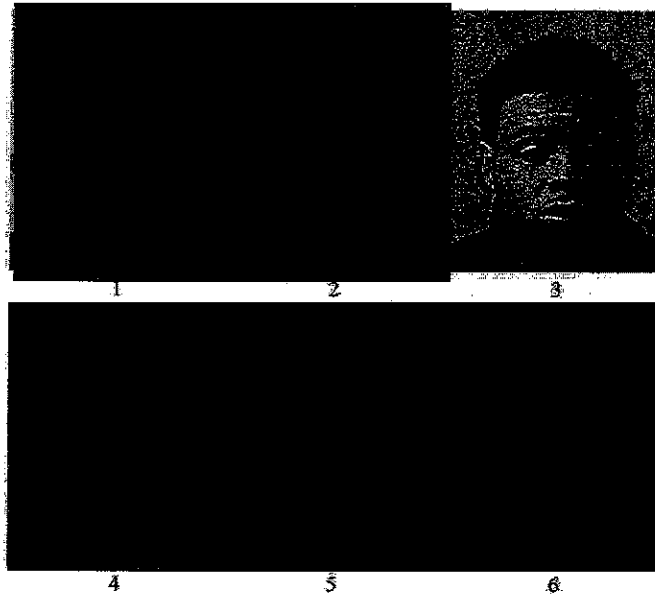
